
Dear Company Representative,

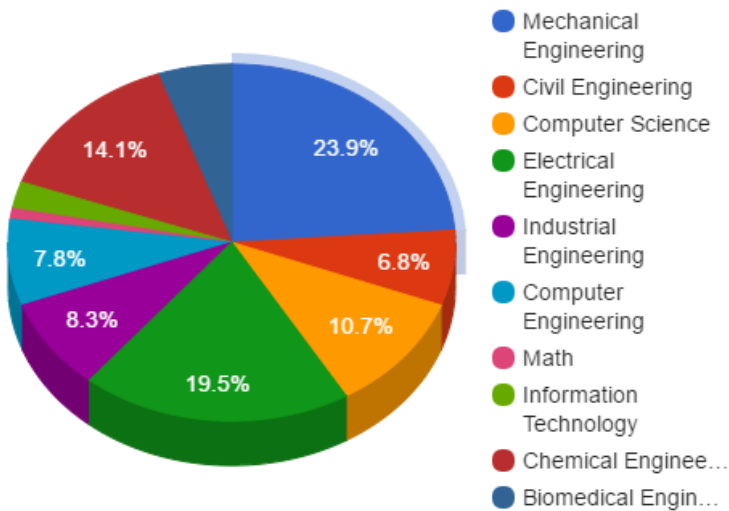

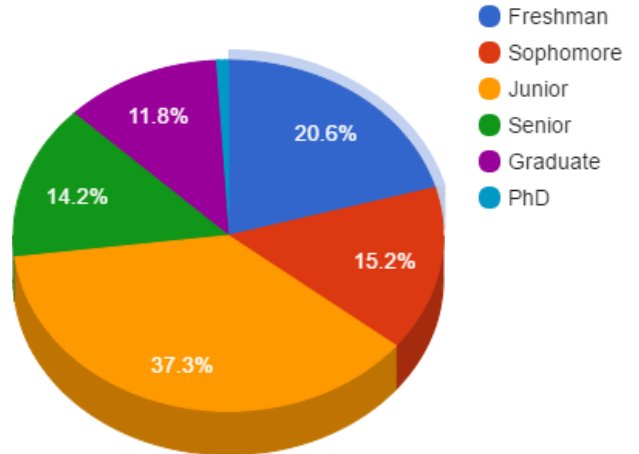
V. 2015 Attendance
